

Some things to remember on a competition day

- Students will respect the members of other bands and display the highest level of good sportsmanship at all times.
- Students are **not** allowed to leave the campus we are visiting at any time for any reason. This includes local malls, fast food establishments, or visiting friends or family who may live in the area.
- Students will always leave an area cleaner than how it was found when on the campus we are visiting.
- When a student gets out of uniform, they must always hang up and put all uniform parts away properly. The uniform carts will be inspected after EVERY performance. If any part of a uniform has been put away incorrectly, that student will be assigned uniform duty.
- All students must travel to and from every competition on the buses. This is for the safety and communication of instructions to all students. Students may only go home with a parent at the end of a competition day if they have 1. signed a permission slip AHEAD of time and 2. checked out with the director following the awards ceremony. It MUST be in writing. This is for the safety of all students. A Parent/Guardian must sign and return this form if you will be going home with a parent instead of on the bus. Students are not allowed to drive to or from the competition. No student may leave the competition until the awards ceremony is completed if they are going home with a parent. Remember, you MUST check out with the director at the buses following the awards ceremony. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- All students are responsible for loading and unloading their own equipment. No one will be responsible for this except the student. It is the student's job to make sure it has been loaded and unloaded. This includes all instruments and guard equipment. If you are going home with a parent after the competition, YOU must make sure you have designated someone to unload it for you. Do not expect it to be done for you. This includes ALL percussion equipment for the battery and pit.
